## Supplies to keep at school:

- Earbuds or headphones
- 4 black EXPO low odor erase markers
- 24 #2 pencils -Ticonderoga brand - NO MECHANICAL PENCILS ☹
- 2 red ink pens
- 2 or more white Pentel Hi-Polymer erasers
- 2 highlighters
- 24 count crayons - nothing larger
- 2 large Elmer's glue sticks
- 1 pair of pointed Fiskars scissors (no plastic)
- 1 box 12 ct. sharpened colored pencils - nothing larger
- 1 handheld pencil sharpener for colored pencils
- 1 stenographer's notebook
- 10 plain two-pocket folders with prongs - paper folders, not plastic
- 1 plastic ruler (standard & metric)
- 1 3 subject spiral notebook
- 1 pencil pouch with zipper - not a plastic school box
- 2 ultra fine-tipped black Sharpies
- 1 large box of tissues
- 1 container Clorox wipes
